


ACTS 8:1-8

Born and Raised in Adversity




- ▶ Founder and King murdered 7 weeks before the beginning and launch
 - 3,000 souls added to the church (2:41)
- ▶ Problem of need for thousands of traveling Jews (2:45)
- ▶ Peter and John arrested and threatened (4:1-22)
 - Number increases to 5,000 men (4:4)


- ▶ **Ananias and Sapphira's deception (5:1-11)**
 - **Believers increasingly added, multitudes of men and women (5:14)**


- ▶ Apostles arrested, threatened and beaten (5:17-40)
- ▶ Grecian widows neglected (6:1-7)
- ▶ Stephen arrested and murdered (6:8 – 7:60)
- ▶ Great persecution against the church (8:1-3)
- ▶ Church scattered (8:4)
 - Multitudes converted in Samaria (8:6)

Born and Raised in Adversity




- ▶ Simon offers Peter a bribe (8:14-25)
 - Saul converted (9:1-30)
 - Church at peace, edified, multiplied (9:31)
 - Cornelius converted (10:1 – 11:18)
- Jews in Jerusalem contend with Peter over preaching to a Gentile (11:2)
 - Church established in Antioch (11:19-26)


- ▶ **Famine in Judea (11:27-30)**

 - **Appointed elders in every church (14:23)**

- ▶ Paul and Silas beaten and imprisoned in Philippi (16:16)
 - Philippian Jailor converted (16:25-34)

- ▶ Paul shipwrecked (27:1-44)



Adversity

Because of Their Preaching

- ▶ They kept their focus and maintained an evangelistic spirit (Ac.11:22; 1Thess.1:8)
- ▶ They prayed for more boldness (Ac.4:29)
- ▶ They *kept their eye on the ball* – Evangelism distracts us from our own suffering! (Ac.5:40-42; 20:22-24)

Adversity

Church Problems

- ▶ They didn't avoid them but addressed them!
 - Church discipline (Ac.5:1-11; 1Cor.5:1-13)
 - Grecian Widows (Ac.6:1-7)
 - Doctrinal Issues (Ac.15:1-29; 2Cor.10:3-5)
 - Warned of Dangers (1Tim.4:1-6)

Adversity of Suffering

- ▶ They manifest joy in the midst of suffering
 - Apostles after arrest and beating (Ac.5:41)
 - Paul and Silas in prison (Ac.16:23-25)
 - They had already “counted all things loss” (Phil. 3:7-8, 10-11, 15-21)

Adversity of Poverty

- ▶ They shared with and were a “part of” one another
 - The beginning of the church (Ac.2:45)
 - “one heart and one soul” (Ac.4:32-37)
 - Gentiles sharing with Jews (Ac.11:27-30)
 - “companions” (Heb.10:33-34) (Eph.4:16)
